We are pleased to announce the commencement of trials using an innovative security system as an initial step to achieve our objective.

Description of Trials:

While continuing to use the existing security facilities, we will assess the effectiveness and deployment strategies of face recognition cameras and scanners capable of detecting dangerous items carried by people on the move.
