## All Nippon Airways to Launch Narita - Vladivostok Service on 16 March 2020

All Nippon Airways (IATA code: NH) will launch a new service between Narita and Vladivostok on 16 March 2020. This will be the first direct service by a Japanese carrier between Japan and Vladivostok and promises to greatly improve the convenience of travel between the two countries.

Vladivostok is a mere two and a half hours flight from Japan and is the closest European city. Visitors can stroll through the unique cityscape of this port city in Russia's Far East or set out on a journey to Russia's interior or Europe from the Vladivostok Station with its beautiful exterior architecture and the starting point for the Siberian Railway.

The city is a popular destination for women and solo travelers and a tourism spot that people continue to go back to for its quaint alleys filled with shops and traditional restaurants offering Piroshiki and other delights.
