

Narita International Airport Operations

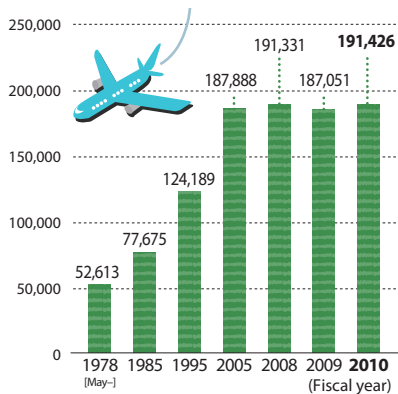
Narita International Airport handled approximately 191,000 flights, 32,520,000 passengers and 2,070,000 tonnes of air cargo in fiscal 2010. Compared to figures when the airport first opened, this was 3.6 times more flights, 4.6 times more passengers and 6.3 times more air cargo—demonstrating significant growth in the airport's operations.

New services on Asian routes and more flights on existing routes continued and the total number of flights for the fiscal 2010 was the second highest in the airport's history after fiscal 2007 (194,115). Although passenger traffic increased satisfactorily in the first half of the fiscal year, figures remained around the same as the previous year as a result of the issues surrounding the Senkaku Islands, the spiraling yen and the Great East Japan Earthquake, etc. Domestic passenger traffic was the highest on record with the introduction of new services and a major increase in the number of flights. Air cargo broke through the 2,000,000 tonnes barrier for the first time in three years.

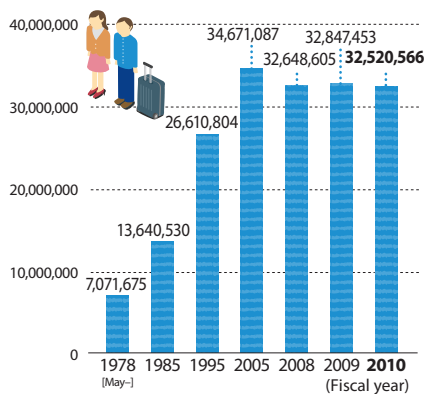


Operations Report (Fiscal 1978-2010) * Including domestic services

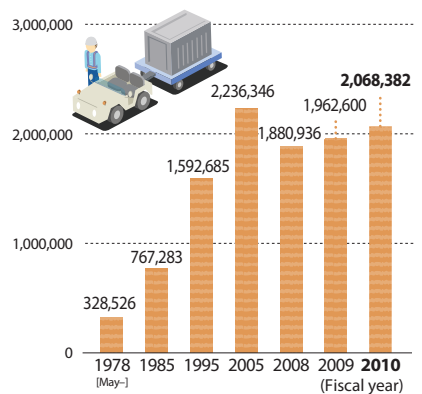
Aircraft Movements (fts.)
