Tokyo, 13 July 2016 : As part of the Narita Air & Bus project to offer direct services to popular tourist locations, new bus routes were launched at Narita Airport to Nikko, Niigata, and Toyama & Kanazawa this spring along with refreshing of the Kyoto route.

As a new addition to this lineup, we are pleased to announce the launch of a service to the World Cultural Heritage Site, Mount Fuji. This service will provide affordable and comfortable access to this most celebrated mountain in Japan, which is also an extremely popular destination with visitors to our country.

In addition, from August, the Kyoto route will be extended to Universal Studios Japan® and its fares will be revised to enable customers to travel at more attractive prices.

- ✓ **Direct access, no connection bus transfers!**
This will be the first direct express bus service from Narita Airport to Mt. Fuji. Whether it be for some serious mountain climbing or a casual visit to enjoy the scenery, bus user can travel in comfort with their luggage stored in the bus baggage compartment.
- ✓ **Two round trips a day! Schedule suitable for both novice and experienced climbers**
[Mountain shack overnight plan] : Depart Terminal 3 (6:30) → Change to local mountain bus at Mt. Fuji Station → Arrive at Mt. Fuji's 5th Station (halfway point), begin climbing at around midday → Stay overnight at mountain shack → Next morning, observe the sunrise → Climb down and board the bus back to Mt. Fuji Station → Change bus and depart Mt. Fuji Station (11:45)
[Daytime climbing plan] : Depart Terminal 3 (17:50) → Spend the night at local accommodation → Next morning, begin climbing → Reach summit → Climb down on the same day and board the bus to Mt. Fuji Station → Change bus and depart Mt. Fuji Station (21:10)
- ✓ **Stops at Fuji-Q Highland Amusement Park along the way!**
Customers using the morning service from Narita Airport (arrives at Fuji-Q Highland Amusement Park at 10:30) can make a day trip to Fuji-Q Highland, a popular amusement park and enjoy its attractions until evening!
Fuji-Q Highland has some of the most thrilling roller coasters in the world and is sure to offer excitement and a stunning view of Mt. Fuji!
- ✓ **Wide variety of tourism packages**
Useful sightseeing package plans are available, including the Mt. Fuji & Five Fuji Lakes Passport Package Plan (one-way express bus ticket + excursion pass) and the Fuji-Q Highland Admission Ticket Package Plan (round-trip express bus ticket + admission ticket). (Sales scheduled to commence in August or later)
