Tanabata Festival Tree Decorations

Tanabata festival tree decorations, a traditional summer ritual of Japan, will be on display at Narita Airport. The displays will comprise real bamboo trees, some as tall as 3 meters, and fabric-covered folding screens with a pattern reminiscent of the Milky Way, to create cool, elegant areas of privacy. Visitors will have the chance to experience the traditional practice of writing wishes on a strip of paper and tying it on to one of the bamboo twigs. These written prayers will be dedicated at the Katori Jingu Shrine in Katori City, Chiba Prefecture.
