### Chushingura Procession

Following on from last year, a parade will be held again this year featuring the Chushingura (Treasury of Loyal Retainers). Chushingura tells the story of the Ako Incident (involving the Forty-seven Ronin) which is a popular performance in Kabuki and Japanese puppet shows (Ningyo Joruri). The procession will recreate the Chushingura scene with the Forty-seven Ronin of Ako parading through the areas after outbound passport control in their costumes, and posing for photographs.

Events are held every day in the departure area after the security check and passport control.



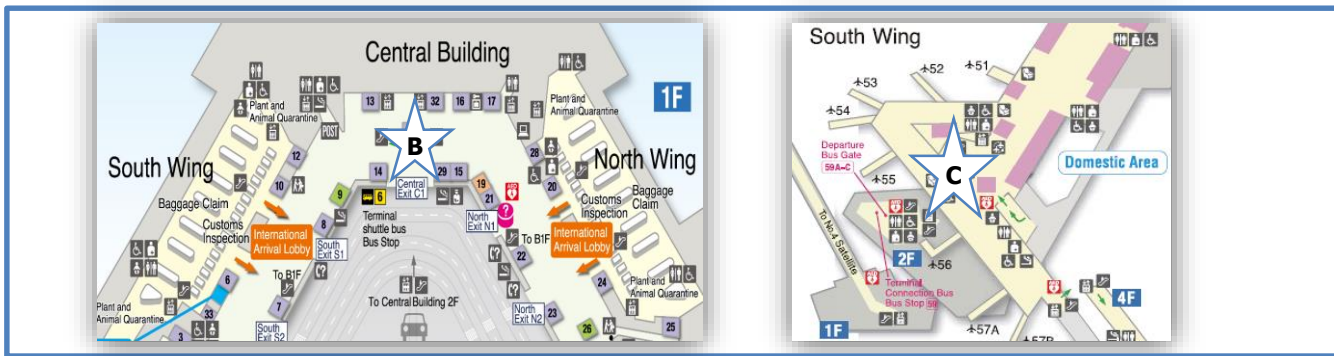
