

Jeju Air to Launch Narita-Daegu Service from 28 October 2018 - More Choice for Travel between Narita and Daegu -

Jeju Air (IATA code: 7C) will launch a new flight service between Narita and Daegu, South Korea from 28 October 2018. Already flying to Seoul (Incheon) and Busan from Narita, Daegu will be Jeju Air's third destination from Narita, operating total of 40 flights per week to these three destinations. Jeju Air will have the most number of routes and flights from Narita Airport than any other Korean LCCs.

Greater Daegu is South Korea's third largest city next to Seoul and Busan, and has a population of 2.5 million. A metropolis of a long history, it is home to historical structures and features a large number of gourmet dining and shopping places. Widely known as "Coffee City", Daegu has many fashionable cafes and bakeries which feature on social networking sites and is a "must visit" for coffee lovers.

At present, there are two flights everyday from Narita Airport to Daegu. Jeju Air's new service to Daegu will increase this to three flights a day and make travel to Daegu so much more convenient. Narita Airport will remain committed to extending its network of destinations to offer greater convenience to its customers. This new Jeju Air service provides one more reason to take advantage of Narita Airport's growing network of destinations.
