The first event will be appearances by sumo wrestlers in traditional mawashi. Sumo wrestlers will appear in the terminals to the sound of the yose-taiko (style of drum used to announce an event)

A great opportunity to experience sumo up close with its classic shikofumi (ceremonial lifting of each leg and slamming it down on the wrestling ring) and suriashi (shuffling across the ring without lifting the feet) exercises. A great opportunity for photos.

New! First timers will be able to try their hand at the basics and take home written instructions on folding patterns.



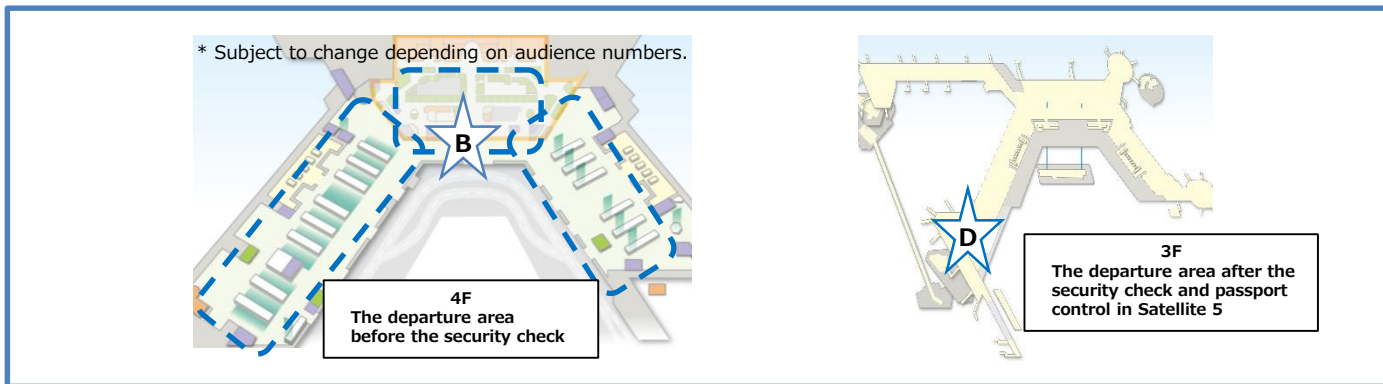
