Events are held every day in the departure area after the security check and passport control.



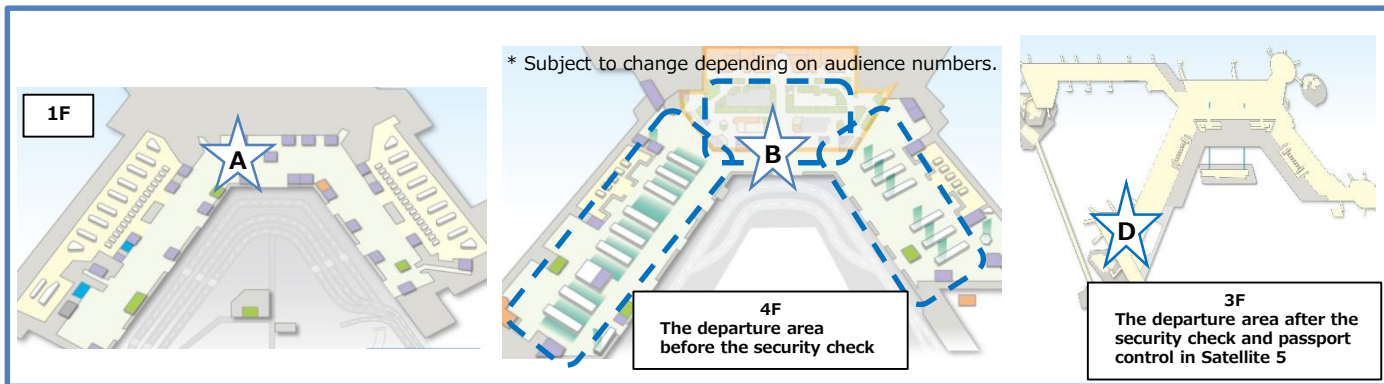
