Formerly known as Astana, Nur Sultan is the capital of the Republic of Kazakhstan which is the 9th largest country in the world. In 1997, the country's capital was relocated to Nur Sultan, which is famous for its futuristic design by Japanese architect Kisho Kurokawa. Kazakhstan is located on the east-west route and is packed with tourism highlights in the majestic natural and cultural heritage that visitors find overwhelming.
