

Air Busan Launches a New Narita - Incheon Route on 25 May 2022

Air Busan (IATA code: BX) launches a new service between Narita and Incheon on Wednesday, 25 May 2022. This will be the airline's second service at Narita Airport after its Narita - Busan operation. Air Busan, known for its low-cost, high-service flights, is based in Busan, South Korea and began operating in October 2008.
