

Jeju Air Launches Cargo Flights Between Narita and Incheon on July 2!

Jeju Air (IATA code: 7C) operates passenger services between Narita and Incheon and launches cargo services on the route on July 2 (Saturday). The airline was established in 2005 and since that time, has continued to expand its network as a leader in taking on new challenges and adopting continuous innovation. With the launch of cargo service this time, Jeju Air enters the cargo transportation business in earnest. For Narita Airport, this is the first LCC to operate cargo flights with freighters since it opened.

International cargo at Narita Airport reached a record high of 2,591,255 tonnes in 2021, up 32% from the previous year. With the strong demand for air cargo, figures in 2022 are also better than pre-COVID levels.

Jeju Air mainly handles e-commerce items such as clothing and sundry goods and is expected to add extra impetus to air cargo traffic between Japan and Korea in areas of cargo which have been strong performers during the COVID pandemic. Narita Airport will continue to work on expanding its international cargo network in order to provide even more convenient services.
