

Hong Kong Air Cargo Launches Cargo Flights Between Narita and Hong Kong on July 9!

Hong Kong Air Cargo (IATA code: RH) launches a new cargo service between Narita and Hong Kong on Saturday, 9 July 2022. Hong Kong Air Cargo is a Hong Kong based cargo carrier established in 2007 and provides air cargo transport across an extensive Asia-centric network.

International cargo at Narita Airport reached a record high of 2,591,255 tonnes in 2021, up 32% from the previous year. With the strong demand for air cargo, figures in 2022 are also better than pre-COVID levels.

Hong Kong Air Cargo carries a wide variety of cargo from apparel to fresh food and auto parts on its network extending widely throughout Asia from its Hong Kong International Airport hub and is expected to inject more stimulus into air cargo traffic between Japan and Asia. Narita Airport will continue to work on expanding its international cargo network in order to provide even more convenient services.
