New Narita - Calgary Service (Canada) to be Launched by WestJet on May 1, 2023!

WestJet (IATA Code: WS) will launch a new service between Narita and Calgary from Monday, 1 May 2023. This is the only nonstop service linking Japan and Calgary and is also the airline's first Asia route.

WestJet is a Low Cost Carrier (LCC) based at Calgary International Airport with a network focused mainly on North America but also extending to Europe and Central America. The launch of this service will offer more convenient travel between Narita and Calgary, and connections linking North America and Asia.

Calgary is the gateway to the Canadian Rockies with their majestic mountains and crystal clear lakes, and attracts visitors from all over the world. In recent years, travel to Japan has become increasingly popular in Canada, particularly among younger generation, and this route is expected to promote further interaction between Japan and Canada.
