

Hospitality Program for International Transit Passengers

Tokyo, 26 March 2015 : As part of our ongoing effort to become the airport of choice for our customers, April 2015 will see further development in our ongoing hospitality program for international transit passengers, including free use of lounges, use of showers at half price and more events to introduce Japanese culture.

Free use of Traveler's Lounge Rassurerants and 50% discount on showers!

- Transit passengers connecting between international flights can use "Traveler's Lounge Rassurerants" free of charge (as compared with 50% discount in 2014). They also qualify for a 50% discount on the use of showers. (Continued from 2014)
- Please present documentation (e.g. ticket or boarding pass) for your connecting flight at the reception counter of the respective facilities to receive these benefits smoothly.

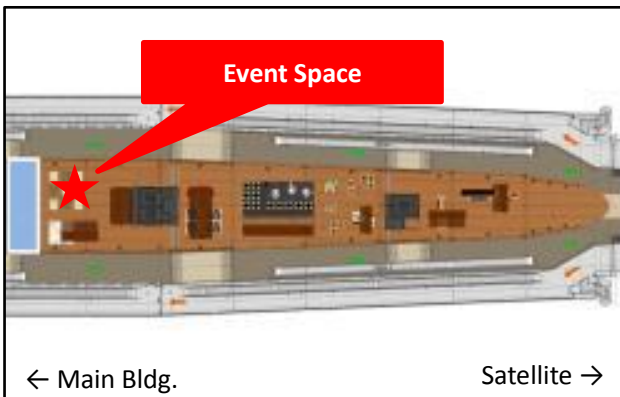

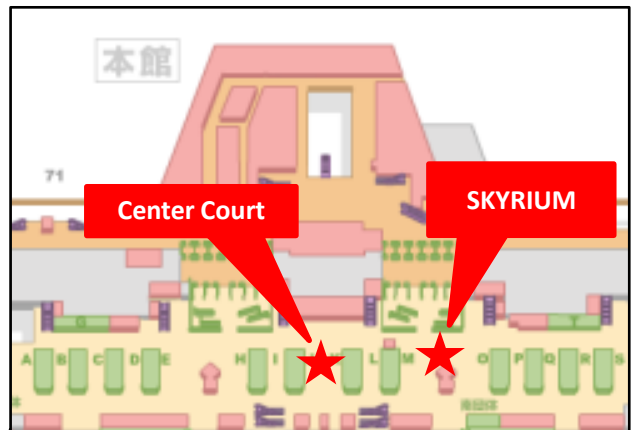
