Tokyo, 25 June 2015: In July, we are hosting more "Welcome to Narita Airport" events for visitors from overseas so that they can learn more about Japan and so that we may encourage them to return to Japan in the future.

Prior to departure, the visitors can experience and enjoy Japanese culture through a variety of events and displays. These include the lively Nankin Tamasudare (Nanjing Lily) performances and the displays of Tanabata star festival decorations at various locations throughout all terminals, including new Terminal 3. In addition, we will have a range of displays and events by local high school students that proved so popular last year. These include demonstrations of the tea ceremony, calligraphy and Koto music. We will also have Bonsai and Karesansui (Japanese rock garden) displays.

Here, you can experience this traditional Japanese festive custom of taking a strip of Japanese paper and writing your wish on it - such as for a safe journey or for the good health of your family members - then tying it on to one of the bamboo twigs. The paper strip bearing your wish will be dedicated to the god at Katori Jingu Shrine in Chiba Prefecture.

On 7 July, the airport staff will welcome you in traditional yukata summer kimonos and hand out Japanese fans at all terminals. At "SKYRIUM" in Terminal 2, you can try on a yukata and enjoy the Japanese summer in this cool style.

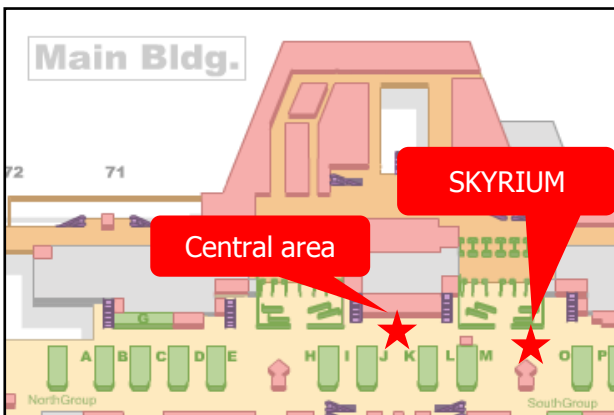

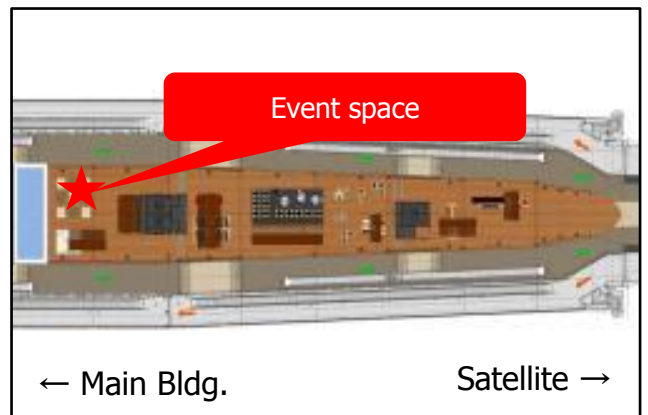
Terminal 1, South Wing

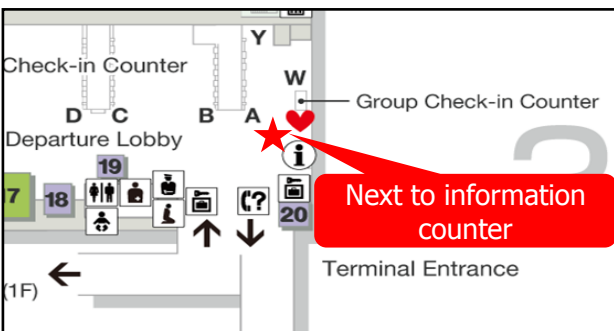
Terminal 1, Airside 3F
