## SIM Card Vending Machines for Overseas Visitors Now Available at Narita Airport from Friday, 24 July - For a Smoother and More Comfortable Start to a Trip -

Tokyo, 17 July 2015: In order to offer improved convenience to customers visiting Japan from abroad, on Friday, 24 July 2015, we will install vending machines in the arrival lobbies of Narita International Airport and launch the sale of prepaid SIM cards for mobile data transmission within Japan.

The vending machines will accept credit card payments and will be available around the clock.


Customers on late-night and early morning flights may now use their own devices, immediately after arriving at Narita.
