

All Nippon Airways to Launch Narita - Phnom Penh Route on September 1!

- Phnom Penh in Cambodia to become a new destination on Narita Airport Network -
- ANA's Phnom Penh route to begin its first scheduled flights -

20 January 2016: Narita International Airport Corporation(NAA) is pleased to announce that All Nippon Airways (IATA Code: NH) (ANA) will launch its new service between Narita and Phnom Penh on 1 September 2016.

Phnom Penh is the capital of Cambodia and has a population of over 1.5 million people. As one of the five nations in the Mekong Region, Cambodia has experienced tremendous economic growth in recent years. Many Japanese companies are expanding businesses into this country. Thanks to these new direct flights, the convenience of doing business with Cambodia from Japan will be increased. By opening this new route to Phnom Penh, ANA will have the largest network of flights from Narita Airport to Southeast Asia, operating 70 passenger flights on 8 routes per week. For Narita Airport, the expansion of the network to reach the long-awaited new destination of Phnom Penh in Cambodia means that it will become involved in rapidly growing Asia activities, and we are very glad of this development.
