Narita Air & Bus Nikko Route to be Upgraded!



Direct express bus service to Nikko!



Increasing bus frequency and becoming a year-round operation

Since 2015 summer, "Narita Air & Bus" service offering affordable direct bus services to tourist destinations from Narita has developed into operating five routes. Currently Nikko, Niigata, Toyama & Kanazawa, Kyoto & Universal Studios Japan®, and Mt. Fuji & Fuji-Q Highland routes are running. Last year, the Nikko route was operated as a seasonal service from April to November only. With the recent growth in the number of visitors to Japan, **from April this year, the service will be made available all year round and the bus frequency from Narita will be increased to three daily run from the twice daily last year.**

These buses will provide greater convenience also for domestic LCC passenger to visit this World Heritage site.

- ✓ Nikko Tourism leaflets are provided on this service in cooperation with Nikko City.
- ✓ Once on the bus, tourist can read the leaflet and get information about the official Nikko City app, "Nikko Strolling Navi" for local information to look into tourist attractions, recommended routes for a walk and coin-operated lockers and many other useful facilities.
- ✓ The first bus arrives at Nikko Station at noon and passengers can start sightseeing straight away. The second bus is for tourists who want to go straight to their accommodation by arriving Nikko Station around 3.00 p.m. **The third bus, which is the new addition, is for customers who arrive at Narita Airport later in the day, and the bus departs from Narita Airport at just after 2:30 p.m.**
